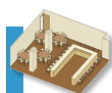
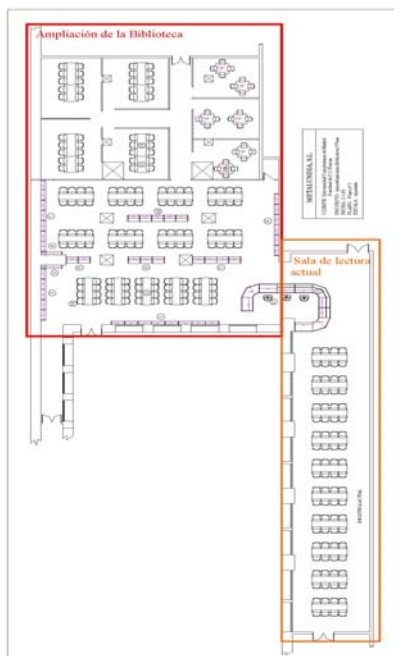

Reading rooms and places

Reading rooms and other research locations

We have **101** desks distributed as follows:

GROUND FLOOR: Loans

- Reading: **92** reading desks

1ST FLOOR:

- Media room: **8** computer workstations

- Scholarly journals, reference and reading room: **1** reading desks



Collections and codes

- Free access to monographs (catalogue code **F**): 8927 items. *
- Journals (**H**): 1191 titles. *
- Reference books (**R**): 601 items.
- Rarely used (**J**): 2942 items.
- Special collections (Science Fiction, Movies, etc.) (**O-N-V-DVD**) 259 items.
- Rare and old items collection (**A**): 4474 items.*
- Theses and dissertations (**T**): 2.629 items.*

Additionally there are another 15000 items located at departmental libraries.

*This collections are, momentarily, not in use because of some building work.

The catalogue code indicates where the title can be found.

For example, **F537.8PUR**

- One or more letters on the right margin of the code indicate the collection to which the item belongs

(e.g. in this case **F** stands for open access monographs)

- the numbers show the subject (e.g. **537.8**: indicates "Computational Databases")

- Letters on the left margin represent the author

(**PUR**: Purcell, Edward M.).

How to use the library

Who. All members of our university community may have access to all of our services, including borrowing books and accessing our online collections off campus. Members of the UCM Alumni Association and Friends of the UCM have access to some of our services such as home loan.

Our materials can be used by all patrons in reading rooms (restrictions may apply during examination periods). Visitors who wish to use services including borrowing books must be recognised by a professor to obtain from the Director of the Library a valid **library card**, which is personal and non-transferable. For some services a PIN number is required.

Improper use of materials or inappropriate behaviour towards our staff or other users constitutes gross misconduct and will be dealt with by academic or legal authorities (Library Rules).



Get to know your library

The library offers **library tours** regularly scheduled and by prior appointment.

Where to find the collections

Books: the most recent and in-demand titles can be found in the open access rooms (on the ground floor). Earlier titles are located in the deposit (code D) or display cabinets (code V). Please request these at the loan counter. There is also an open access science fiction collection (code N on the 1st floor).

Journals (code P): the latest numbers are available on the journal display shelves on the 3rd and 1st floors. Earlier copies can be found on restricted access shelves and should be requested at the loan counter.

CD-ROM, DVD y other materials: (codes CD, DV, DQ, VI, CDP, T, TC and F) can be requested on the 1st floor counter.

Loans, renewals and reserving

Loan conditions:

Reference books (encyclopaedias ...), journals, unpublished theses, and works of special value cannot be checked out on loan.

Penalties:

Two-day loss of privileges for each day overdue.

Library Hours: From 9:00 to 20:45.

Deadlines and number of titles:

- Students: 12 titles (15 days).
- Researchers and UCM administrative staff: 20 (1 month).
- UCM faculty: 35 (2 months)

Renewals and reserving.

Reservations and renewals of books in the catalogue may be made using your PIN.
Renewals of books in Spanish are excluded)
