BÚSQUEDA CONJUNTA. GESTIÓN DE RESULTADOS

- **ACCESO AL TEXTO COMPLETO:** Cuando encontramos un artículo de nuestro interés, podemos acceder al texto completo del mismo si aparece el botón “Full text”. En otras ocasiones, podemos enlazar a información relacionada o al texto completo desde otros proveedores de texto completo, desde el enlace “Otros recursos”:



- **SELECCIÓN DE RESULTADOS:** Los resultados pueden ordenarse según diferentes criterios, entre ellos la relevancia. Desde la pantalla de resultados, si no establecemos nuevas limitaciones para nuestra búsqueda, podemos acceder a Scientific Web Plus, para conocer páginas web de calidad e interés para nuestra búsqueda. Al realizar una selección, desde el enlace “Marked list” (Lista marcada), podemos imprimirlos, enviarlos a una cuenta de correo, guardarlos o enviarlos a un gestor bibliográfico. También podemos analizar los resultados y generar informes por autor, tipo de documento, categorías generales, lengua, año de publicación, fuente o área temática.

BÚSQUEDA CONJUNTA. GESTIÓN DE RESULTADOS

- **INFORMACIÓN ADICIONAL. NAVEGACIÓN POR DOCUMENTOS SIMILARES:**
Cuando encontramos un documento que nos interesa, pinchando en el título podemos acceder a información adicional y complementaria: además del resumen y, en su caso, el texto completo, podemos ver otros artículos escritos por el/los autores del trabajo de nuestro interés; artículos citados y citantes; mapa de citas (citation map) con la representación gráfica de esa red de citas; crear una alerta de ese artículo, para recibir notificación cuando sea citado por otro trabajo dentro de WOK; acceder a artículos relacionados (comparten citas con nuestro artículo, por lo que se presupone una coincidencia temática) incluidos en la Web of Science; o conocer el factor de impacto de ese año para la revista en la que se publicó el trabajo de nuestro interés.
- Además, desde el registro individual de un trabajo, también se ofrecen las opciones de imprimir, guardar, enviar a una cuenta de correo o a un gestor bibliográfico.

Abstract: News media coverage of health topics can frame and heighten the salience of health-related issues, thus influencing the public's beliefs, attitudes, and behaviors. Through their routine coverage of scientific developments, news media are a critical intermediary in translating research for the public, patients, practitioners, and policymakers. Until now, little was known about how health and medical science reporters and editors initiate, prioritize, and develop news stories related to health and medicine. We surveyed 468 reporters and editors representing 463 local and national broadcast and print media outlets to characterize individual characteristics and occupational practices leading to the development of health and medical science news. Our survey revealed that 70% of respondents had bachelor's degrees; 8% were life sciences majors in college. Minorities are underrepresented in health journalism; 97% of respondents were non-Hispanic and 93% were White. Overall, initial ideas for stories come from a news source followed by press conferences or press releases. Regarding newsworthiness criteria, the potential for public impact and new information or development are the major criteria cited, followed by ability to provide a human angle and ability to provide a local angle. Significant differences were seen between responses from reporters vs. editors and print vs. broadcast outlets.

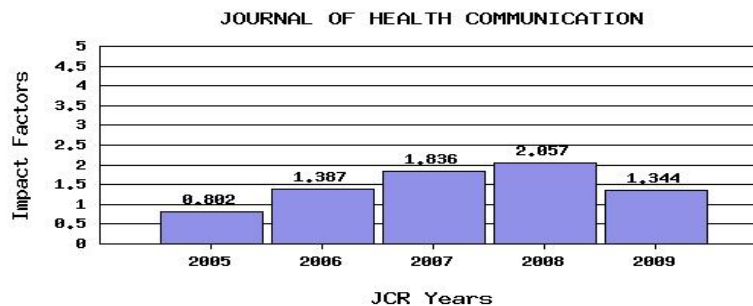

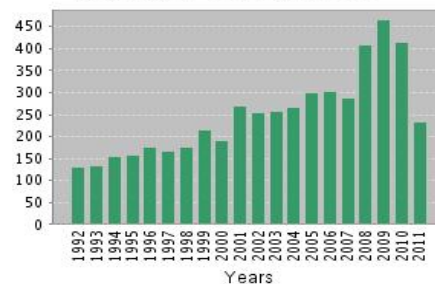

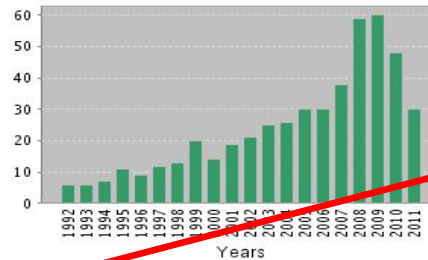

WEB OF KNOWLEDGE. JCR Y OTROS RECURSOS

- **QUÉ ES:** Es una de las bases de datos integradas en el portal Web of Knowledge. Ofrece información sobre el impacto y la importancia relativa de las revistas científicas de un área en comparación con otras de su misma especialidad, a partir del cálculo del factor de impacto de la revista. 



UCLA'S YANG YANG ON POLYMER SOLAR CELLS



Yang Yang of UCLA discusses his work on polymer solar cells and the challenge of extending their efficiency and effective lifespan to a point at which solar cells can compete with those derived from silicon. Potential near-term applications include cells lining briefcases or purses, with the capacity to charge electronic devices, while the ultimate goal is lightweight solar panels that could be affixed to a house exterior as easily as a poster. From the interview: "We started working on polymer solar cells about eight or nine years ago. I had a student who was about to graduate, and I challenged him to work on a project that was not associated with his Ph.D. thesis. I was working on silicon-based solar cells, and he chose polymer..."
