

HOW TO USE THE LIBRARY

Who. Members of the university can use all our services, ask for loans and get into our electronic funds. Members of public universities of Madrid, of Ancient Student Associations and Friends of the UCM have access to some of our services

Any people can consult our funds in the reading room (during examinations times some restrictions may apply). For using other services or for making loans you have to be introduced by a professor or by the Director of the Library. For that, it is complimentary to have the library card, wich is personal and, for some services, you need the PIN (Personal Identification Number)

Improper use of funds or inadequate treat to our staff or to the rest of the users are considered as a grave infraction.



The Library organizes guided visits addressed to help you better know our Library, every Friday at 12 and at 16 h.; you need to ask for it in the loan desk

Group visits also exist, teachers or other interested people need to ask for them.

We also organize, at the beginning of the academic period, the Welcome Week to the Library, with daily visits (at 12h and at 16 h.)



TRAINING
