- Special materials: 8.100

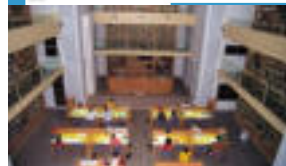
The catalogue code indicates where the title can be found. For Example:

LA 612.84 AGU

- The first letters indicate the collection (in this case **LA** stand for 'open access'),
- the numbers show the subject (**612.84**: Ocular physiology),
- and the last letters represent the author **AGU** (Aguilar, Mariano).

How to use the library

Who. All members of our university community may use all our services and borrow books by means of a valid **library card** which is personal and non-transferable. For access to our online collections off campus a PIN number is required. Members of the UCM Alumni Association and Friends of the UCM have access to some of our services such as home loan.

Our materials can be used by everybody in the reading rooms (restrictions may be in force during examination periods). Visitors who wish to use other services or borrow books must be introduced by a professor or by the Library Director.

Improper use of materials or inappropriate behaviour towards our staff or other users constitutes gross misconduct and will be dealt with by academic or legal authorities (Library Rules).

Journals (code PP): the latest numbers are available on the hemeroteca. Earlier copies can be found on restricted access shelves and should be request at the circulation desk.

CD-Rom, DVD and other materials: (codes V, I, O): can be requested at the circulation desk.

Loans, renewals and reserving

Loan conditions:

Reference books (encyclopaedias ...), journals, unpublished theses, and works of special value cannot be taken out on loan.

Fines:

Two days for each day overdue.

Library Opening Hours Monday to Friday , 9 a 21 h.

Deadlines and number of titles:

- Students: 8 titles (7 days).
- Researchers and administrative personnel: 12 (15 days)
- Teachers: 25 (2 months)

Renewals and reserving.

Reservations and renewals of books in the catalogue may be made using your PIN.
