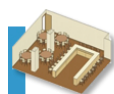
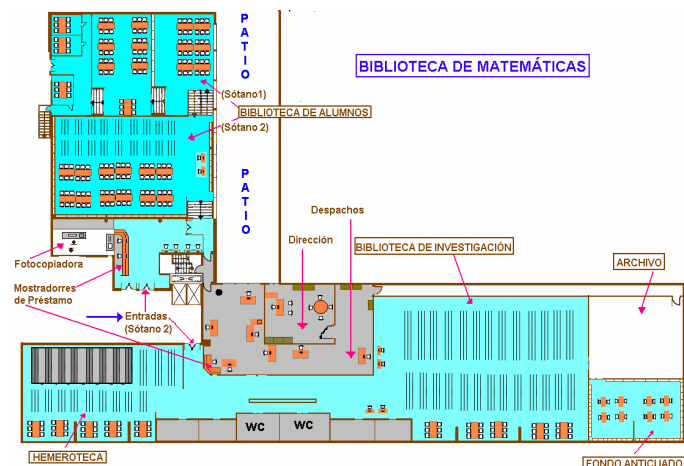

The **classmark** is a code that helps to locate a document in the library.

Example:

AL512.64BUR

- First letters indicate the collection (in this case **AL**, Biblioteca de Alumnos),
- the numbers of the subject (**512.64**: Linear algebra),
- and the last letters, the autor **BUR** (Burgos Román, Juan de)

How to use the library

Who. Members of the university can use all our services, ask for loans and get into our electronic funds. Members of public universities of Madrid, of Ancient Student Associations and Friends of the UCM have access to some of our services such as loans.

Any people can consult our funds in the reading room (during examinations times some restrictions may apply). For using other services or for making loans you have to be introduced by a professor or by the Director of the Library. For that, it is complimentary to have the library card, which is personal and, for some services, you need the PIN (Personal Identification Number).

Improper use of funds or inadequate treat to our staff or to the rest of the users are considered as a grave infraction.

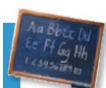


Get to know your library

The Library organizes **guided visits** addressed to help you better know our Library, every Friday at 12 and at 16 h.; you need to ask for it in the loan desk.

Group visits also exist, teachers or other interested people need to ask for them.

We also organize, at the beginning of the academic period, the **Welcome Week to the Library**, with daily visits (at 12h and at 16 h.).



Training courses

The Library organizes **free courses** on how to use our electronic resources, every week both in the morning and in the afternoon. For registrations and further information visit the public information desks or buc_mat@buc.ucm.es.

Loans, renewals and reserving

Loan conditions:

Reference Works (encyclopaedias...), unpublished thesis, works before 1959. and some of high value are excluded.

Fines:

Two days without loan for each day of delay.

Opening hours: from 8:30 to 20 h.

Loan Periods and number of Books of limitations:

- Students: 8 books 7 day
- Researchers: 12 books 15 days.
- Teachers: 25 books 2 months..

Renewals and reservations. You can delay. reserve and renew your loans. For doing so, you need your card and your PIN.
