

Reading rooms and places

We have 392 reading places distributed as follows:

- Open access room: 202 places
- Reference room: 120 places
- Journals room: 48 places
- Media room and study room: 14 places



Collections and codes

The library's collection is comprised of monographs, serials, statistics, working papers, films, documentaries..., in a variety of formats.

- Journal titles: 1.991
- Books: 177.491 Special materials (CDs, DVDs...): 3.112

Every item has a catalogue code (signatura) which indicates where the title can be found.

Take for example: D 316.334.3 BOT

- The first letters indicate the collection (In this case **D** stands for "Depósito"
- Stacks) The numbers represent the subject (316.334.3
- Political sociology), The last letters refer to the author (BOT: Bottomore, T.B.)

How to use the library

Who. All members of our university community may use all our services, take out books on loan and access our online collections off campus. Members of the UCM Alumni Association and Friends of the UCM have access to some of our services such as home loan.

Our materials can be used by everybody in the reading rooms (restrictions may be in force during examination periods). Visitors who wish to use other services or borrow books must be recognised by a professor or by the Director of the Library by means of a valid **library card**, which is personal and non-transferable. For some services a PIN number is required.

Improper use of materials or inappropriate behaviour towards our staff or other users constitutes gross misconduct and will be dealt with by academic or legal authorities (Library Rules).



The library organizes occasional ${\bf guided\ tours}$ and by prior arrangement to further awareness of its services.

The holdings are divided into two main collections:

- Free Access Collection: Basic bibliography, handbooks and manuals (L), Statistics (E), Reference books (R), working papers (W), films, documentaries (V), Journals (alphabetic order).
- Book Stacks Collection: 19th century books (A), Gómez Arboleya Collection (GA), books published before 1958 (DP), books published after 1958 (D y N), Journals (PP), videos and DVDs (ME), CDS (CD). To consult these materials it is required to fill out a request form at the help desk.

Complaints or suggestions. You may complain or make suggestions in person, or by e-mail. We will contact you as soon as possible.
