PULMONARY THROMBOEMBOLISM

Etiology

Recognition and awareness of pulmonary thromboembolism has increased dramatically in the last few years. Thrombi may develop as a result of a combination of two or more of the following processes: 1) hypercoagulability, 2) vascular endothelial damage, or 3) abnormal blood flow patterns or blood stasis.

Vascular endothelial damage is an integral part of sepsis as a sequela of systemic inflammatory response syndrome (SIRS). Diffuse vascular damage occurs frequently as a consequence of a variety of inflammatory disorders, such as sepsis or pancreatitis, or immune-mediated diseases.

Definitive diagnosis of pulmonary thromboembolism is made by selective angiography. Although selective angiography of the pulmonary artery can be performed using plain radiographs, it is invasive because of the need for catheter placement in the pulmonary artery. Instead, CT angiography, although more expensive, provides improved imaging of clots and is less invasive because the contrast medium can be injected through a peripheral vein. Thoracic CT also allows imaging of the lung parenchyma which can provide further diagnostic information. Unfortunately, CT is expensive and not always available, and does require anesthesia, which increases the risk in these hypoxic patients. Alternate imaging techniques are also possible. The finding of abnormal perfusion on scintigraphic ventilation/perfusion scanning is also strongly suggestive, but not diagnostic, of thromboembolic disease.

Infectious diseases of the respiratory system are common in small animals, particularly the pediatric patient. The most commonly observed infectious diseases include feline upper respiratory tract infections, tracheobronchitis, and pneumonia. It is important to be vigilant, as occasional other conditions may mimic pulmonary infection, including diaphragmatic hernia, congestive heart failure and pyothorax. Most treatment is supportive.

However, the hospitalization costs for such puppies can be significant, particularly if oxygen or intensive nursing care is required. The primary therapy focuses on supportive care, including fluids (subcutaneously or intravenously), antibiotics, and monitoring appetite and blood glucose levels. Nebulization and gentle coughage may be very helpful in clearing infection. Antibiotic choices are usually empiric, even if a tracheal wash is performed, it is several days until bacterial culture and sensitivity data are available. Antimicrobials with good activity against *Bordetella* include aminoglycosides, fluoroquinolones, chloramphenicol, trimethoprim-sulfa and tetracyclines. 

2 Words, phrases and terms

A search query may be broken up into terms and operators.

There are two types of term: Single Word Terms and Multi-Word Phrases.

A Single Term is a single word such as cat or dog.

Multiple words, when entered into the search box, are treated as Single Terms and combined with an "invisible" AND.
